Rules and Regulations

Administrative Regulations Policy 125.0 Volunteering with Williams County EMS



Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to regulate volunteering with Williams County EMS for the safety and security of the fire department and the community.

Policy

The City of Bryan Employee Handbook #108 shall be the primary standard for volunteering with Williams County EMS.

Bryan Firefighters are allowed to volunteer with Williams County EMS under the following conditions:

- 1. The Firefighter shall not volunteer with Williams County EMS on his/her Crew day or while on duty.
 - a. The Firefighter cannot get someone to cover his/her crew so they can run with Williams County EMS. This shall be strictly forbidden and subject to progressive discipline.
- 2. The Firefighter shall present to the Chief's office by the last day of each month, before the first day of the new month the schedule of the individual with the dates they will be volunteering with Williams County EMS.
- 3. The Firefighter shall not respond to fire calls while on duty (call) volunteering with Williams County EMS.
- 4. No more than three (3) Firefighters shall be on call with Williams County EMS at any given time.

Emergency Modifications

Due to the nature of responses made by the City of Bryan Fire Department, exceptions can only be made to this policy by the Fire Chief, Assistant Fire Chief or their designee. The Fire Chief, Assistant Fire Chief or their designee reserves the right to call a volunteer into service, in the event of an extreme emergency.

Violation of Policy

Violation of this policy will result in either or both:

- Progressive discipline
- The violator will be asked to terminate volunteering with Williams County EMS if they wish to remain with the City of Bryan Fire Department.
