## **Standard Operating Guidelines**

Guideline 207.0 Mutual Aid



## **Purpose:**

The purpose of this Standard Operating Guideline is to give guidance in regards to request for assistance at fires with our neighboring fire departments and those that we have mutual aid contracts with.

## **Guideline:**

The standard request for mutual aid will be *Crew Alarms* for <u>single piece requests</u> and *General Alarms* for <u>multiple piece requests</u>.

The department that is requesting assistance will specify the type of equipment needed.

If the requesting department requires an Engine and Manpower, We will respond with an Engine and Rescue 25.

The apparatus manning SOG will be followed for responses to requests for mutual aid.

All move-ups and standbys of equipment and/or manpower will be on a non-emergency response unless requested by the requesting authority to be an emergency response.

In the event that The City of Bryan Fire Department cannot fill the request for automatic aid, the Officer in charge shall notify the requesting department that we will not be able to fulfill their request for assistance.
