A Letter from the Chief

February was a busy month for our firefighters with 42 calls for service. During this winter month, our firefighter responded to three calls for carbon monoxide. It is very important to have your gas heating appliances checked at least annually, to ensure that they are performing properly. Also, check and change the filter according to your furnace manufacturer directions.

Time change to Daylight Savings is coming up March 7. That is a good time to check your smoke detectors and CO detectors, and change the batteries. It is also a great time to talk with your family about what to do in case of a fire. Have a plan. Practice it. Make sure everyone knows what to do.

We continue to monitor the coronavirus situation just as you probably are. Your firefighters are prepared to respond in the event that this virus ends up visiting our area. As we said last month and continue to say and follow CDC guidelines, with all of the flus and colds going around this time of year, take time throughout the day and wash your hands with soap and water on a regular basis. It has been shown that soap and water is better than the sanitizers are. Although sanitizers work in a pinch, nothing beats soap and water. Just like preparing your family for fires, have a plan and be ready.

Your fire department is here to help. If you would like we can come to your home, help you look for those hidden hazards, help you and your family develop a plan and help keep your family safe. If you want us to come to your home, contact Assistant Fire Chief Doug Pool and set up an appointment.














