A Letter from the Chief

While we are in the throngs of the Coronavirus pandemic, your fire department continues to respond to and is prepared to respond to your needs. Calls for service during the month of March saw a slight decrease by six calls from February. To this point, your fire department has responded to 120 calls for service. Based on current data we are on track to where we normally are at this time of year.

This time of year brings about springtime and yard cleanup. Please remember there is no burning allowed in the City of Bryan and if you live in any of the subdivisions outside the City, there is also no burning allowed there either. You can take your yard waste to your recycling center for your particular area. Contact your township trustees for those who live outside the City and for those who live inside the City you can take your yard waste to the recycling center on Buffalo Road.

With the stay at home order in place, now is a good time to practice your fire escape plan with your children. Also now is good time to go over your severe weather plan.

We continue to monitor the coronavirus situation and we are prepared to respond. We know how hard it is to have to stay home right now but by doing so, we are actually saving lives and reducing the possibility of getting sick ourselves. We ask that you continue to do your part and stay away from others as much as possible to contain the spread of this deadly virus. We want all of you to come out on the other side of this thing alive and well. Please follow the orders giving by our Federal, State and Local authorities. It is for everyone's well-being. We will get through this.
















