Your Fire Department continues to respond to your needs. Calls for service in July stayed the same as June, 35. July also had saw an increase in the number of calls as compared to last year. To this point, your fire department has responded to 253 calls for service for 2020. Based on current data our current call volume is down overall 49 calls compared to the same time last year. We continue to be on course for our annual call volume of 400 + calls for service.

Now is also a good time to practice your fire escape plan with your family as with the summer months the kids are at home. Also with the warmer weather comes severe storms. So, go over your severe weather plan.

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









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




