2020 has finally closed. It has been a different type of year. However as we reflect and review this past year, it has been a year in which we all have learned and grew in the face of adversity. While we are not back to what we call "normal", I have faith that 2021 has promise.

With more and more people working from home and staying home, nationwide we are seeing an increase in home fires and other calls for service. Please be careful. Check all of your gas fired appliances and make sure that they are operating properly. Carbon Monoxide is a colorless, odorless, tasteless gas that is created from our gas-fired appliances such as furnaces, stoves, dryers, and hot water heaters. If these appliances are not properly maintained or are not working correctly, they can give off this deadly gas. Please take the time to get them checked before something bad happens. Install a Carbon monoxide detector in your home. Cooking, heating, electrical, smoking and candles are all leading causes of home fires. Please be careful with all of these. Check your smoke detectors regularly to ensure they are working. If they are ten years old or older, it is time to replace them. If you do not know how old your smoke detector is, go ahead and get a new one. Please take the time to practice your fire escape plan with your family.

Your fire department responded to 414 calls for service for 2020. In December, we responded to 39 calls. This is down by two from last December. Thank you for all that you do. You are very important to us. We look forward to serving you in 2021.

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



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

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


