A Letter from the Chief

February turned out be a very busy month for our firefighters. We responded to 41 calls for service this month. An increase of 11 from last month and an increase of three calls from a year ago.

A number of the calls for service in February were for Carbon Monoxide events. Remember Carbon Monoxide is a colorless, odorless gas that displaces the oxygen in our cells. Carbon Monoxide is the result of incomplete combustion. Usually from a malfunctioning gas-fired hot water heater, furnace, stove, or clothes dryer. Please check all of your gas fired appliances and make sure that they are operating properly. If these appliances are not maintained properly or are not working correctly, they can give off this deadly gas. Again, please take the time to get them checked before something bad happens. Also, Install a Carbon monoxide detector in your home.

Cooking, heating, electrical, smoking and candles are still the leading causes of home fires. Please be careful when using all of these. Check your smoke detectors regularly to ensure they are working. If they are ten years old or older, it is time to replace them. If you do not know how old your smoke detector is, then the best advice is to go ahead and get a new one. Also, take the time to plan and practice your fire escape plan with your family.

Continue good fire safety practices.


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Incident Count per Zone for Date Range



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




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Average Turnout Time per Shift for Date Range






