A Letter from the Chief

Fall has arrived. Temps for the month are still warm for this time of year but a cool down is coming. Your Bryan firefighters responded to 40 calls for service in September. The pandemic is still an issue. Please be safe.

Now is a great time to get your furnaces ready for the heating months. Carbon monoxide is a colorless odorless gas cause from incomplete combustion. If your furnace is not functioning properly, it can give off this deadly gas. Every home should have a Carbon Monoxide detector. Get one and put it up. Your life and your family's life may depend on it.

Nationally, there are still many grill incidents this time of year, and many home fires are caused by them. The National Fire Protection Association has a safety tip sheet for us about grilling. Although we have not had any bad storms, we need to prepare our families and ourselves when they do strike. The National Weather Service has some great tips at their website. Cooking, heating, electrical, smoking and candles are still the leading causes of home fires. Please be careful when using all of these. Check your smoke detectors regularly to ensure they are working. If they are ten years old or older, it is time to replace them. If you do not know how old your smoke detector is, then the best advice is to go ahead and get a new one. Also, take the time to plan and practice your fire escape plan with your family.

Next month is fire prevention month. But fire prevention should be every day. Please be safe.

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



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



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

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

Non-Personnel Attendance per Event Type for Date Range


