In order to ensure proper pick-up, we do ask a few things from you... All refuse must be placed at the curb by **6:00 a.m.** on your collection day.

ALL trash & recyclables must be placed in the carts provided by Republic Services.

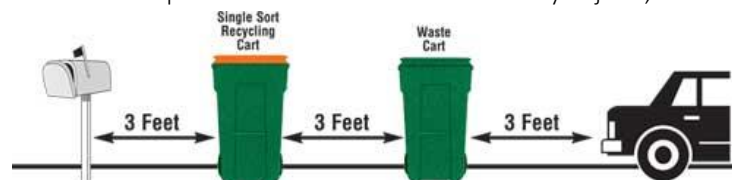
Welcome!

As a new residential customer to Republic Services, we would like to inform you of the services you will receive. Our frontline team members are eager & excited for this opportunity to provide you with the essential services each and every day.

This is a brief overview of services; a more detailed information will follow in a pamphlet that will be attached to your carts during delivery. A new and exciting way of collecting your trash and recycling is here. With the delivery of your Republic Services[®] cart, you have the ease of a rolling cart, along with the durability of a proven collection system. Using automated collection carts can be more efficient than hand pickup. It also makes trash set-out easy and hassle-free. While you review the basic procedures, please note the single most important factor is creating a safe and contained way to collect your household trash. Thank you!

CART DELIVERY: 96-gallon containers will be delivered the week of June 27th to your residence. Residents do NOT need to call to set up an account. If you had trash & recycle service from the City of Bryan, invoices will now come directly from Republic Services on a quarterly basis. The Trash charge on your City Utility bill will be removed beginning July 1, 2022

CART SERVICE: To guarantee that your rubbish and bi-weekly recyclables are removed on your scheduled day (map will be in pamphlet), please have your trash and recycling containers available at the curb no later than 6am and ensure your container is placed at least 3 feet from stationary objects,



Carts can be set out after 6pm on the day before collections. Empty carts need to be removed from the curb by 11:59pm the day of service. When not in use, carts shall be stored in a garage or outbuilding. When no such building is available, carts shall be stored in a fenced area, side-yard, backyard or area not otherwise visible from the street.



Residents may write their address on a piece of tape and attached it to their container. You may not use anything to permanently mark your cart.

DAY OF COLLECTION: Waste and bi-weekly recyclable materials will be picked up on a designated day each week (map will be in pamphlet)

Downtown residents will have trash picked up by hand, as usual, without carts. Those pick-up dates will be on Tuesday's (unless it falls on a holiday).

Residents that wish to drop off Recyclables can drop them off at WiltonKeck Recycling at 807 E. Maple St. Entrance is on Toy St. If the bins are full, please drop off during business hours (6:30 AM – 2:30 PM Monday-Friday). The following will be accepted: cardboard, newspaper, magazines, office paper/shredded paper, #1 and #2 plastic bottles, and shredder steel.

HOLIDAYS WE OBSERVE: If your pick-up day falls on or after a holiday it will be 1 day behind.

- New Year's Day
- Memorial Day
- Independence Day
- Labor Day
- Thanksgiving Day
- Christmas Day

BULK ITEMS: 1 large item will be collected once a month, on Tuesdays (a map will be in the pamphlet) Bulk item is defined as larger pieces of furniture, mattresses (fully wrapped), box springs (fully wrapped), chairs, sofas, rolls of carpet and padding (not to exceed 3 ft. sections and bound), and non-Freon® household appliances. Bulk/heavy items must be able to be safely lifted into the collection trucks. Items that are too heavy will not be taken.

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

- Lumber, building and remodeling materials, construction materials
- Tires and automobile parts (including batteries)
- Stones, rocks, or dirt
- Steel, aluminum, vinyl, or iron fencing, auto or construction materials
- Explosives, pathological and biological waste, radioactive material, ashes, and sand
- Motor oil, pesticide containers, paint thinner and sealant containers
- Other items that may be banned from landfills

**You can order a roll off dumpster for construction and demolition debris as well as larger household cleanups.

The City of Bryan Street Dept. will continue the limb and brush pick-up and will follow the schedule for the one large item pick-up

- Grass, yard waste and leaves can still be dropped off at the Buffalo Rd. facility
