

Fireworks Information

The City will be following the State Laws concerning Consumer Fireworks and Discharge OAC 1301:7-7-56(Z). In short this means discharge of fireworks are only on specific days as set forth in OAC 5626.5.1. (which is roughly 14 days throughout the year). The time restriction on this is 4pm-11pm with the exception of New Year's Eve, which is from 4pm New Year's Eve until 1:00 am New Year's Day.

However, there are restrictions on discharging:

- The handling and discharge of 1.4G fireworks by any person under the age of eighteen is prohibited.
- The presence of any person under the age of eighteen within 150 ft of the point of discharge of 1.4G firework aerial devices is prohibited.
- Pointing, aiming or discharging of 1.4G fireworks at or towards any person, object, including bystanders, spectators, emergency vehicles, etc. is prohibited.
- The ignition or discharge on public or private school property, any street, highway, alley or public way is prohibited.

OAC 5626.5.7.1 Separation distance from spectators, buildings or structures shall be at least 150 feet on aerial, and 50ft on ground display. Distance is tripled for multifamily dwellings i.e.: Duplex, triplex and apartment complexes.
