

## General Information

**TIME OF COLLECTION:** To ensure the removal of your recycling and waste materials, please place the waste cart at least 3 feet away from the recycle cart as well as any other objects no later than 6 a.m. of your collection day.

**DAY OF COLLECTION:** Waste and recyclable (bi-weekly) materials will be picked up on the designated day each week, except when a holiday falls on or before your regular pickup day. Then, your pickup schedule will be delayed one day. See inside of pamphlet for specific every-other-week recycling information.

### HOLIDAYS THAT AFFECT COLLECTIONS:

New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

**CART PLACEMENT:** Place carts within 3 feet of the curb with the arrows facing the street. Do not place carts near mailboxes or other fixed objects. ***Note: Do not place carts at the curb prior to 6 p.m. on the day before collection. Please remove empty carts within 12 hours following collection.***

While you review the basic procedures, please note the single most important factor is creating a safe and contained way to collect your household recycling and trash. *Your 96-gallon cart will be delivered the week of June 27, 2022.* We want to make this process as easy as possible. *The following items can always be placed in your recycling cart: **Paper, cardboard, plastic, aluminum, metal and glass***

*Please make sure your recyclables are **empty, clean and dry** before placing them in your recycling cart.*

#### PLACEMENT OF CARTS

Solid waste will be serviced at the curb in front of your home. Keep the carts at least 3 feet away from all other objects such as trees, bushes, mailboxes, fencing, landscaping and your other carts. ***Please do not park vehicles in front of carts.***

## Bulk/Heavy & Larger Items Pickup Program

Residents are allowed to set out large or heavy items 1x per month on the Tuesday of your designated day of each month. (*See the Bulk Routing Map for more information*)

**BULK/HEAVY ITEMS:** Defined as larger pieces of furniture, mattresses (fully wrapped), box springs (fully wrapped), chairs, sofas, rolls of carpet and padding (not to exceed 3 ft. sections and bound), and non-Freon® household appliances, not to exceed 40 lbs. Bulk/heavy items must be able to be safely lifted into the collection trucks. Items that are too heavy will not be taken.

#### WE CANNOT PICK UP THE FOLLOWING ITEMS FOR SAFETY AND HEALTH REASONS:

- Lumber, building and remodeling materials, construction materials
- Tires and automobile parts (including batteries)
- Stones, rocks or dirt
- Steel, aluminum, vinyl or iron fencing, auto or construction materials
- Explosives, pathological and biological waste, radioactive material, ashes and sand
- Motor oil, pesticide containers, paint thinner and sealant containers
- Other items that may be banned from landfills

Residents may also contact Republic at **800.589.7852** or [RepublicServices.com](https://www.RepublicServices.com) to order a roll-off dumpster for larger size projects.

The City of Bryan Street Dept. will continue the limb and brush pickup. The schedule will follow the one large item schedule. Grass and leaves can still be dropped off at the Buffalo Road facility

#### WHO DO I CALL IF I HAVE QUESTIONS OR MY CART IS NOT PICKED UP?

#### CAN I PUT MY ADDRESS ON MY CART?

You may write your address on a piece of tape to attach to your cart. Excessive labeling of the cart tends to give the neighborhood a careless look and gives the appearance of graffiti.

#### WHAT IF MY CART IS SEVERELY DAMAGED, LOST OR STOLEN?

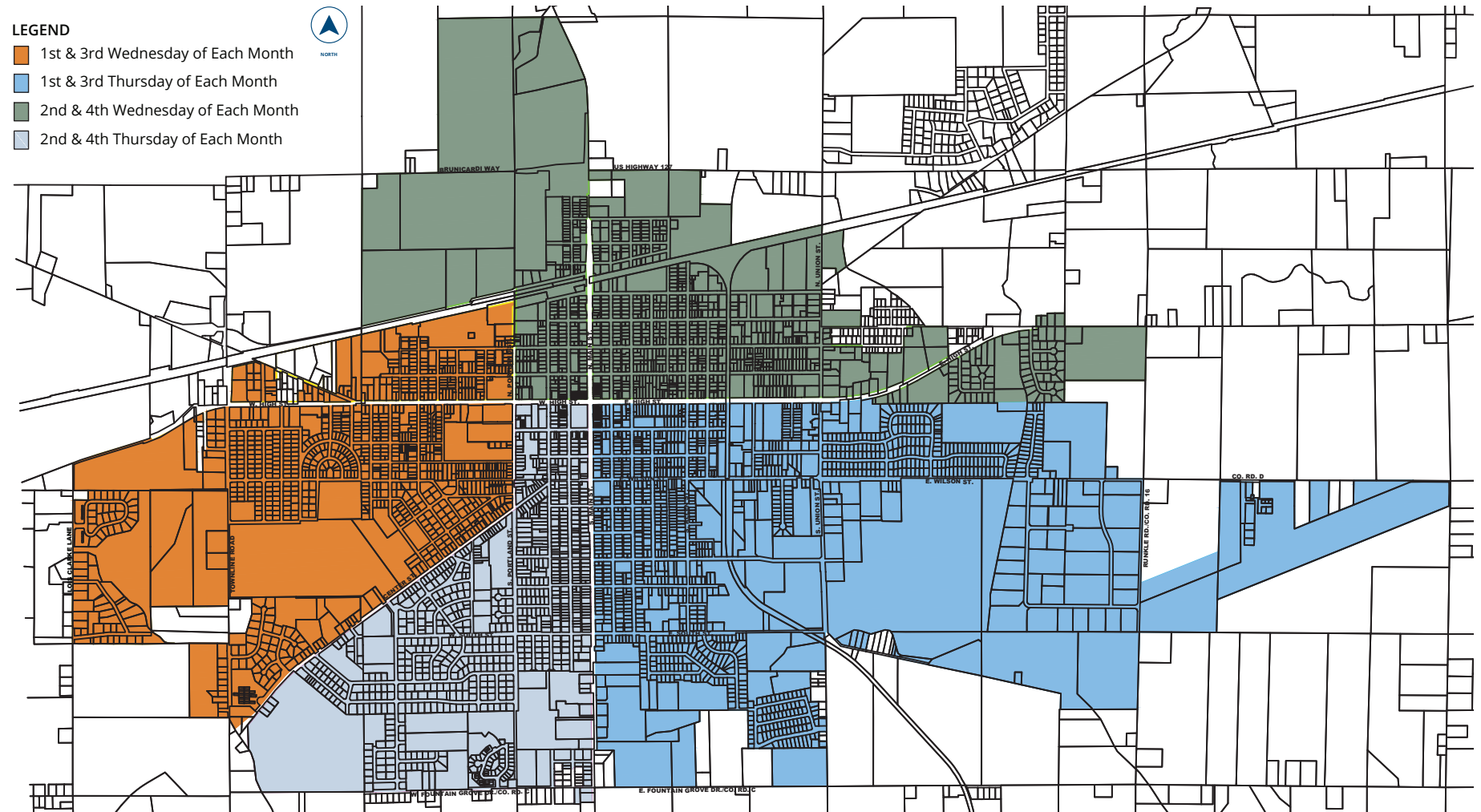
Simply call Republic Services at **800.589.7852** for a replacement cart.

#### WHAT TIME SHOULD I PLACE MY CART AT THE CURB?

Carts may be placed out the day before the scheduled pickup. If you live on a one-way street, place cart on the passenger side of the street. Do not place cart at the curb prior to 6 p.m., the day before collection.
