Duty Crews



Purpose

In order to offer the best protection to the citizens we serve, the City of Bryan Fire Department must provide service 24-hours a day to the City of Bryan and areas served contractually or through mutual-aid. The City of Bryan Fire Department will accomplish this in the most efficient and effective way possible.

Policy

Members of The City of Bryan Fire Department assigned to a rotating shift, on-call or part time coverage. Each Shift will rotate as the Duty Crew for twenty-four (24) continuous hours beginning at 0700 hours until the following day at 0700 hours at which time the next Crew will be on duty. The Duty Crew will be responsible for all single apparatus responses, such as trash fires, and EMS assist, etc. An officer will be assigned to each Shift. Members of the Crew shall be responsible for calls for assistance while on duty.

In the event that a member is not able to fulfill his/her obligation of being on duty, it is his/her responsibility to notify the Fire Chief or Chief's designee as soon as possible.

Exception to this policy is during the member's normal hours of work at their primary place of employment unless deemed necessary by the Fire Chief.
