A Letter from the Chief

August is a month of transition. We have completed Firefighter level 2 training. A new class is getting ready to start entry-level training. It is back to school for firefighters and kids alike. The month of August has been busy with emergency responses. We traveled to the turnpike for a mutual aid call that was taking nearly 25 minutes to arrive using back road access to the construction zone. A late month barn fire in Center Twp. was at the far end of our first response area. The firefight lasted only a few hours, but firefighters remained on scene for several days as the debris continued to burn. After discharging 45,000 gallons of water with little effect on the burning straw and hay and clearing nearby equipment, the fire was contained and allowed to burn. This was the safest course of action.

As days begin to shorten and nights are cooler, now is the time to check your furnace and make sure your carbon monoxide detector is working.



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












