

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING – WILLIAMS COUNTY
PY 2022 COMMUNITY HOUSING IMPACT & PRESERVATION- LEAD ABATEMENT PROGRAM
(CHIP-LAP)**

The Ohio Department of Development's Office of Community Development is has partnered with the Ohio Department of Health (ODH) to make funds available for the Community Housing Impact & Preservation - Lead Abatement Program (CHIP-LAP). The CHIP-LAP Program will include funding for Equipment and/or Lead-Abatement activity costs associated with eliminating lead-based paint hazards in homes receiving CHIP Program Assistance.

Williams County is the lead entity in the Maumee Valley North CHIP Consortium (MVNCC), which includes Williams County and the City of Bryan. Williams County submitted an application for CHIP funds on June 22, 2022 for funding on behalf of the MVNCC. Williams County intends to apply for CHIP-LAP funds, with the application deadline of September 28, 2022.
