Now is a great time to get your furnaces ready for the heating months. Carbon monoxide is a colorless odorless gas cause from incomplete combustion. If your furnace is not functioning properly, it can give off this deadly gas. Every home should have a Carbon Monoxide detector. Get one and put it up. Your life and your family's life may depend on it.

Motor vehicle accidents continue account for a significant number of responses. Drive careful. Make sure your windows are clear of frost and fog. Morning and evening sun can decrease visibility even more. Slow down or pull over if you are unable to see clearly due to the glare of the sun.

Bryan Fire Department has initiated the use of in vehicle transponders to alert other vehicles on the roadways. If you are using a navigation system, you may receive an alert of an approaching emergency vehicle. Thank you for pulling to the right and allowing us to respond safely.
















