A Letter from the Chief

Fire prevention activities during the month of October reached over 1200 people this year. School programs, fire station visits and fire extinguisher training for employees at various locations will help keep the community fire safe.

Days grow shorter and nights are getting colder. Did you remember to change the batteries in your smoke detector when you changed the clocks? Check you smoke and carbon monoxide detectors as heating season gets in to full swing.

Thanksgiving meals are being planned. Keep your kitchen safe. Watch what you heat. Remember if you are planning to deep fry that turkey this year to do it safely. Thanksgiving is the peak day for home cooking fires with more than three times the daily average for such incidents. Christmas Day and Christmas Eve ranked second and third, with both having nearly twice the daily average. 






