If you have a live tree, make sure it's fresh and watered. When the needles dropping off is an indication of a dry tree. Consider using battery-operated candles in place of traditional candles. In September, we initiated a vehicle alert system. In just over 2 months on 63 incidents, over 1,100 drivers were alerted to emergency vehicles. Emergency responders are at risk when we are on the roadway. Every year firefighters, EMTs, police officers, road maintenance workers and tow operators are injured and killed when struck by vehicles along the nation's roadways. Thank you for slowing down and moving over.










