A Letter from the Chief

Beginning a new year, we continue to see many of the same challenges of staffing. Resignation of Firefighter/EMT Adam Helms has left an opening for a fulltime firefighter. We are in process of filling the vacancy.

We have seen an increase in medical responses but the number of fires remains consistent. The Bryan Fire Department is ready to respond to any emergency at any time. The best way to protect you and your family is to ensure working smoke and carbon monoxide detectors are in your home. Having a fire extinguisher ready for use can quickly extinguish a fire before it grows out of control. While businesses are required to have fire extinguisher, it is a good tool to have at home. We have responded to several fires over the past year that have been extinguished or held in check until our arrival by occupants using portable fire extinguishers. Fire extinguishers in the home should have an 2A:10B:C rating. These are typically 5 lb. dry chemical extinguishers. Remember to have an escape plan, even when using an extinguisher.








