

## **NOTICE OF CIVIL SERVICE EXAMINATION**

Notice is hereby given that a civil service entrance level examination will be given for the position of **Patrol Officer** for the City of Bryan, Ohio. The position of Patrol Officer starts at \$22.50/per hour. After successful completion of a one-year probation, pay increases to the current contractual rate of compensation. All interested candidates must take the FrontLine National exam through National Testing Network prior to Thursday, August 17, 2023.

The physical fitness testing will be conducted at Bryan City Schools Field House, 1350 West Fountain Grove Drive, Bryan, OH on Saturday, August 19, 2023 at 9:00 A.M. \*Candidates that have been certified by the Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy within one (1) year of the closing date of the written test will not be required to take the department's physical agility provided the candidate supplies the department with sufficient evidence of passing the state test.

All applicants for the above-mentioned position must be at least 21 years of age and possess a high school diploma or General Education Degree (G.E.D.). Successful candidates must obtain or exceed a minimum score for each of the three (3) physical fitness tests, obtain or exceed the minimum required written exam score of 70%, pass a background check, successfully complete an oral interview, pass a voice stress analyzer, psychological, drug and alcohol screen, physical examination, including stress test, using guidelines established by the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund. The candidate(s) appointed to the position must meet the current residency requirements for Police Officers of the City of Bryan. Police Officers shall be, or become residents of Williams County or adjacent Ohio Counties, namely Fulton, Henry and Defiance Counties within twelve (12) months of the date of their employment.

Veterans credit of 20% (required by state law), will be granted to those individuals who show certified proof of Honorable Discharge pursuant to state law and the Local Rules of the Bryan Service Commission prior to the written examination. Additional points will also be given for Ohio Peace Officer certificate, any documented degree issued from an accredited college (copy to be turned in with application to receive credit) and/or current Reserve Officer with the City of Bryan Police Department.

Lateral transfers are available to those officers who have an OPOTA certificate with a minimum of two (2) year full-time experience. With proper documentation at the time of application, those officers will be exempt from taking the written examination. More information is available by contacting the Secretary of the Bryan Municipal Civil Service Commission.

Employment applications must be completed and filed with the Secretary of the Bryan Municipal Civil Service Commission located in the Police and Fire Complex after successful completion of the online written test through the National Testing Network.
