## **Standard Operating Guidelines**

# Guideline 201.0 Alarms and Response



#### **Purpose:**

Responding to different types of emergencies requires a certain type of alarm and a certain number of fire apparatus to respond to these emergencies. This guideline establishes the type of alarms typically sounded and fire apparatus that are to respond to these emergencies.

### **Guideline:**

The following are the different types of alarms that are typically encountered and the type of response that will normally be taken.

Structure Fires: <u>Injury Accident Calls:</u>

Note: Bryan Hospital may say they

have a Code 13 or Code Red.

No entrapment
Crew Alarm

The following list by emergency type is the typical response by fire apparatus and response order.

#### Structural Fire:

House-

City of Bryan-1<sup>st</sup> Engine, Tower, 2<sup>nd</sup> Engine, and Rescue. Rural- 1<sup>st</sup> Engine, Tanker, 2<sup>nd</sup> Engine, and Rescue.

Mercantile or Industrial, Hospital, Nursing Home or School:

City of Bryan-1<sup>st</sup> Engine, Tower, 2<sup>nd</sup> Engine, Rescue and 3<sup>rd</sup> Engine. Rural- 1<sup>st</sup> Engine, Tanker, 2<sup>nd</sup> Engine, Rescue, Tower and 3<sup>rd</sup> Engine

# Automobile Accident with Fire:

City of Bryan- Engine and Rescue.

Rural- Engine, Tanker and Rescue.

### Automobile Accident (no entrapment) Calls:

Engine.

### Automobile Accident With Entrapment Calls:

Engine and Rescue.

## Automobile Fires:

Engine.

### Grass Fires:

Truck 28 and Engine.

Note: May require additional equipment as determined by the size of fire.

## Trash (Dumpsters)/Misc. Fires:

Engine.

## Hazardous Material Spills, Leaks, Fires, etc.:

1<sup>st</sup> Engine, Haz Mat 1, Rescue, and 2<sup>nd</sup> Engine.

Mutual Aid- Haz Mat 1, Engine, and Rescue also, the local fire department of that jurisdiction shall be dispatched.

#### Mutual Aid-

Equipment response and/or manpower as requested.

### Automatic Mutual Aid-

Equipment response will be predetermined and responses will be as listed in the Automatic Mutual Aid books.
