A Letter from the Chief

August is in the books. Event planning for Girl Named Concert brought many agencies together and tested our ability to coordinate operations. It was a huge success. Back to school for kids and future firefighters. Registration for entry-level class at the Bryan Fire Training Academy are at capacity. We have the largest class in 15 years. We hope the trend continues as the number of firefighters in the county has dropped by 30% over the last 20 years.

Recruiting remains difficult for fulltime firefighters. The recent civil service test to fill an open position did not have any qualified candidates complete the process. We are testing again during the month of September to fill an open fulltime position.

First responder calls continue to be a large part of the emergency responses. The Bryan Fire Department has made great efforts to assist citizens of our response area with medical emergencies. Many of the Bryan Firefighters also certified as EMTs. Multiple medical calls overlap and many of those first responders are able to provide care while waiting for medical transport to arrive.

As days begin to shorten and nights are cooler, now is the time to check your furnace and make sure your carbon monoxide detector is working.





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

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

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


