Notice is hereby given that a Civil Service entrance level examination will be given for the position of **Police/Fire Dispatcher** for the City of Bryan, Ohio. The position of Police/Fire Dispatcher starts at **\$18.00/per hour**. After successful completion of a one-year probation, pay increases to the current contractual rate of compensation.

All applicants for the above-mentioned position must be at least 18 years of age and possess a high school diploma or General Education Degree (G.E.D.). Successful candidates must obtain or exceed a minimum required exam score of 70% on the CritiCall test, pass a background check, successfully complete an oral interview, pass a voice stress analyzer, drug screen, and physical examination,

Veterans credit of 20% (required by state law), will be granted to those individuals who show certified proof of Honorable Discharge pursuant to state law and the Local Rules of the Bryan Service Commission prior to the written examination. Additional points will also be given for Ohio Peace Officer certificate, any documented degree issued from an accredited college (copy to be turned in with application to receive credit) and/or current Reserve Officer with the City of Bryan Police Department.

All applications must be completed and filed with the Secretary of the Bryan Municipal Civil Service Commission located in the Police and Fire Complex, and testing must be completed no later than Friday, November 10, 2023 at 3:00 PM. Individual examinations will be scheduled upon the completion of a filed application.

All applications filed must contain, if applicable, a copy of official record/certification signifying honorable discharge from or satisfactory active military service and/or any documented degree issued from an accredited college in order to receive additional points.
