## July 21, 2025

Council President Mary Leatherman opened the meeting with the following members present: Richard Hupe, Jim Kozumplik, F. John Betts, and Stephen Alspaugh. Also attending were: Mayor Carrie Schlade, Wastewater Superintendent Wes Wygant, and Clerk-Treasurer John Lehner.

Mr. Kozumplik moved, Mr. Alspaugh seconded, to approve the minutes of the July 7, 2025 Regular Meeting, as written. Roll call vote: all ayes; nays, none. Motion carried.

Bryan resident Steve Cox inquired as to the start date of the chip and seal pavement work to be done in Eastland Estates. Mayor Schlade said it is scheduled for next week, weather permitting, and that residents would be notified at least the day before.

Mayor Schlade addressed a recent citizen request for the City of Bryan to implement a program to reduce the local squirrel population, stating that the requested action would be illegal, and that the City would not be proceeding in any such effort.

Mr. Kozumplik moved, Mr. Alspaugh seconded, to approve the Clerk-Treasurer's Report for the month ending June 30, 2025 as submitted by Clerk-Treasurer Lehner. Roll call vote: all ayes; nays, none. Motion carried.

Resolution No. 35, 2025, titled,

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING OF A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT REVOLVING LOAN (ED RLF) FUNDS FOR TDK HOLDINGS, LLC FOR THE REHABILITATION OF THE BUILDING AT 113-115 S. MAIN STREET

was presented and read by title only. Mayor Schlade explained the loan would be used for upstairs renovations to include multiple apartments and an elevator. The terms of the loan are \$300,000 at 3.0 percent interest for 20 years.
