# Asphalt Program & Pavement Marking



- Helms & Sons Exc.-
- \$644,690 (1/2% Tax)
- Repaved part of Ashley, Crestview, Fairlawn, Greendale, Westfield and South Street. Also large portions of Center and South Lynn Streets.
- Griffin Pavement Striping, LLP
- \$128,638 (1/2% Tax)

# 2025 Improvements of Blakeslee Avenue

- Final Cost was \$491,592 (1/2% Tax)
- Contractor was M&M Asphalt LTD of Blakeslee
- Full Depth removal and replacement of two blocks of Blakeslee Avenue




# *Safe Routes to School* *Phase 2 Sidewalk*

- Contractor was

- \$230,188 reimbursable  
funding
- New sidewalk on West

Drive to South Main Street




# *2025 South Walnut Area Sanitary Sewer Improvements*

- Bid Price \$408,283 (1/2% Tax)
- Contractor- Vernon Nagel, Inc.
- Will be completing spring of 2026
- 50% covered by OPWC Grant up to \$175,000



# 2025 Lincoln Park Sanitary Sewer Improvements

- Bid Price \$512,342 (1/2% Tax)
- Contractor- S&S Directional Boring
- Will be completing spring of 2026




# *Don North Municipal Building* *Re-Roof*

- Bid Price \$248,607 (1% Tax)
- Contractor- Richland Co. & Associates, Inc.



# *South Myers Street Sanitary Sewer*

- Awarded to:  
S&S Directional Boring
- \$810,760
- Replaced rear-yard sanitary sewer in the South Myers Street area
- Completed summer of 2025
- \$275,000 OPWC Grant



# **2025 PROJECT GRANTS**

## **Reimbursable Grants**

- ODOT Safe Routes to School Phase 2 - \$246,690 cost
  - \$230,188 reimbursed – 95/5
- OPWC South Myers project (2024-completed in 2025) \$810,760 cost
  - reimbursed \$275,000

## **Carry Over 2025 projects with grants not yet complete**

- OPWC East Mulberry Waterline Project with 50/50 grant up to \$275,000 of the \$489,300.40 bid cost – (\$244,650.20 tentative based on bid cost)
- OPWC South Walnut Sanitary Sewer Replacement with 50/50 grant up to \$175,000 of the \$408,283 bid cost

# Code Enforcement

- 134(114) Grass & Weed Violations
  - All Cases Resolved with no Citations

  - All Cases Resolved except **two** that went to Court for citation

**(\$428,800 - 80/20 Reimbursable Grant)**
- ▶ Cherry, Butler, Allen, Wilson San. Sewer \$851,000  
**(\$470,000 CDBG Grant)**
- ▶ Maple to High Alley Sewer (\$350,000)  
**(\$175,000 OPWC Reimbursable Grant)**

# 2026 GOALS

- ▶ Apply for further grant funds to stretch the current ½% Income Tax fund. (**\$1,073,000 in 2026**)
- ▶ Ohio Public Works for Water/Sewer/Street
  - ▶ Joint Water/Pavement projects
  - ▶ Sanitary Sewer Replacement
- ▶ Update 10-year Capital Improvement Plan
- ▶ Sanitary Sewer Capacity Study in spots
- ▶ Continue on **Commercial and Industrial clean-water investigations.**
