

Rental Assistance



The Williams Metropolitan Housing Authority provides rental assistance according to the regulations of the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development. Assistance is given in Defiance County, Fulton County and Williams County to low-income individuals and families on a first-come, first-served basis.

Interested persons must fill out an application to get on the Williams MHA waiting list, which will be opening in August 2026.

When: The Williams Metropolitan Housing Authority will open its waiting list for new applications starting from August 18 at 8 a.m. until August 21 at 11:59 p.m.

How: Applications will now be taken online on the Consortium of Northwest Ohio website located at www.nwohhousing.org.

From August 18, 2026, at 8 a.m. until August 21, 2026, at 11:59 p.m., click on the Williams MHA tab and follow the application link. This is the quickest way to get your name on the list.

If you would prefer a paper application, please call the office between August 18, 2026, at 8 a.m. until August 21, 2026, at 11:59 p.m., and we will mail you an application. The office number is 419-592-1735.

Am I Eligible? If you need help paying your rent due to your income, we encourage you to apply. You do not need to receive any other assistance to qualify. You can have a job and still qualify.
